

Attendance Checklist for Elementary/Junior High Students Infected with Influenza Viruses

Those who are diagnosed with influenza should refrain from attending school until they are well. Students must stay at home for a minimum of five days from the start of their illness and until 48 hours after a fever has resolved.

●Ordinance for Enforcement of the School Health and Safety Act (Standards for Duration of School Absence)

Article 19 Standards for duration of school absence specified pursuant to the provisions of Article 6, paragraph 2 shall be as follows according to the types of infections prescribed in the preceding Article.

1 Until their symptoms have ended for those who are infected with the first group of transmitted diseases.

2 The following period for those who are infected with the second group of transmitted diseases excluding tuberculosis and meningococcal meningitis. Except in cases where there is a diagnosis by a school doctor or other doctors that the student has no possibility of being infected.

-2 A minimum of five days from the start of their illness and until 48 hours (72 hours for infants) after a fever has resolved for those who are infected with influenza viruses excluding bird flu (H5N1) and new flu viruses etc.
